We provide safety and healthy transitions for victims of domestic minor sex and labor trafficking throughout all of our programs, as well as comprehensive prevention and education efforts for the community. Hope and healing is brought to these victims through Hope House Aftercare Services by offering professional case management, access to quality medical care, counseling, therapy and comprehensive support services to ensure the safety and well-being of our youth. We do this while providing consistent residential care, supervision and healthy influences that strive to meet each of their physical, emotional, social, educational and spiritual needs.

Place of Hope at The Leighan and David Rinker Campus offers presentations, trainings and educational workshops to individuals and agencies, as well as business and civic groups that have an interest in learning about ways to prevent human trafficking.

“My Life, My Choice”



Place of Hope at The Leighan and David Rinker Campus offers the “My Life, My Choice” prevention and treatment curriculum provided by the Justice Resource Institute. This is used to empower youth to protect themselves from the commercial sex industry and its predators, as well as support survivors in rebuilding their lives.

Hope Campaign



Hope Campaign is a monthly community outreach in which chapstick, labeled with the National Human Trafficking Hotline, is delivered, along with missing children flyers, to hotels and other locations in various areas of Palm Beach County identified by local authorities as places where human trafficking is likely to occur.

Peninsula Coffee



We are in the process of developing a new social enterprise, Peninsula Coffee, to help combat human trafficking in our community. By buying bags of coffee or using our coffee catering services, community members will be able to provide hope to the victims on our recovery and support programs. This social enterprise will also create jobs for the youth in our care, where they will learn essential life-skills that they can take with them into their careers and gain the experience they need to create bright futures for themselves.




